Financial Planning:

- Collaborate with the Group FP&A Manager to develop and manage forward-looking financial planning processes at the OPCO level.
- Assist in the creation of annual budgets, forecasts, and financial models. Ensure the accuracy and timeliness of financial plans and forecasts for your OPCO.

Financial Control Environment:

- Work closely with the Group Financial Controller to establish and maintain a robust financial control environment at the OPCO level.
- Monitor financial controls to minimize risk and maintain compliance with company policies and regulations.

Financial Analysis:

- Conduct a financial analysis to identify trends, risks, and opportunities specific to your OPCO.
- Provide insights and recommendations to the local management team and senior Group Executive management.

Financial Reporting:

 Assist in the preparation and review of local financial reports, including assisting Group Financial Control to collate management accounts. Collaborate with stakeholders, including donors if applicable, to provide accurate financial reports for your OPCO.

Compliance & Controls:

- Ensure compliance with local taxation and regulatory requirements in your OPCO. Stay current with changes in local tax laws and regulations.
- Support the development, implementation, and maintenance of financial controls and procedures specific to your OPCO.
